



Puppy Pickup's

Our program operates puppy pickups differently than most other breeders. Please read carefully, if you have any questions please reach out to us through call, text, or email.

Puppies don't go home until they're 8 weeks of age and pickups are usually scheduled the weekend during or following their 8 week milestone. All adopters are made aware of when pickup dates will be for a litter prior to placing a deposit so you can plan accordingly to pick up your puppy on puppy pickup weekend.

If by some chance you need a specific day and time the weekend of puppy pickups please reach out to us ASAP. Otherwise when puppies are 5 weeks old we start scheduling adopters day (Saturday or Sunday) and time to pick up their puppy.

We usually do pickups from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. On both days. How our process works is, two adopters are scheduled for the same time slot. It looks like this 10:00 am / #1 or 10:00 am / # 2. It's fairly simple if you have timeslot #1 at that time you'll receive a message to come to the pickup table first provided you've arrived on time. Time slot #2 will receive a message second once we've either finished with the family in slot #1 or if there are two of us working the pickup table as soon as we have your puppy's paperwork pulled up and ready to go over and be signed we will message.

We ask that when you arrive at the designated pickup location that you text us "arrived for (your puppy's litter name)" and wait for us to message you to come to the pickup table to sign your puppy's paperwork, collect their go home folder, then pick them up. You will receive a reply message telling you which of us to go to at the pickup table. We will be wearing different color shirts and you will be assigned to go to one of us wearing the color of the shirt you were assigned as that person will have your puppies paperwork already pulled up for you and ready to go over and sign.

Every litter is given theme names. Everything during your puppies first 8 weeks of life with us is done under their assigned litter theme name and color. This is a way of keeping everything organized. It does not mean you have to keep the name your puppy has been given as an identifier in our program. It's just a way for us to identify and organize their information, as well as our way to keep track of their health and all of their information during their time with us.

We love getting gotcha day photos of our puppies with their families. These photos will be posted on our socials (Facebook and Instagram) and possibly on our website. If you'd rather not have your photo taken when we ask to take your photo with your puppy, please kindly let us know you'd prefer not to have your photo taken.

Please be on time for your scheduled puppy pickup and remember to text us when you arrive and wait in your vehicle until we message you to come to the pickup table to do your paperwork and get your puppy's folder.
