

Microchip & ID Tag Information

Thank you for adding one of our precious babies to your family! Your puppy has been microchipped prior to leaving us. Their microchip has been registered to our program. It is important to register their microchip in your name by making an account through finano.com website and adding your puppys provided microchip number.

A microchip is just like an ID tag in the way that it needs to be updated regularly as your phone numbers and/or addresses change. Please don't forget this! This helps your pet be returned to you if they are picked up by animal control or scanned at a veterinary office.

It is still important to keep a visible ID tag and collar on your dog in the event they get lost; whoever finds them can call you as a microchip can only be scanned by a special device that veterinarians and shelters have. A microchip is a second line of defense on getting your furry family member back home to you.

There are websites that sell inexpensive dog ID Tags such as on Amazon and <u>www.pettags4less.com</u> to name a couple. Please make sure your dog has a collar and tag with the correct contact information on it.

Just a reminder NEVER leave your dogs collar on them while they're in their crate as it could get caught and cause harm or even death to your dog. Get in a habit of putting it on as they exit the crate and taking it back off before they go back in.
